Snow Plowing

Steed's Lawn Care has been contracted to plow our subdivision roads this winter.



Steed's placed stakes in some yards as needed. Please leave the stakes where they were placed until April 1st.

Snow plowing will occur now through April 1st at the end of each snowfall, where there is at least 2 inches of snow on the roads. Steed's already completed our first plow on November 30th.

Any plowing, whether by Steed's or by the County Plows, will result in some snow moving into your driveway.
