PACT

PACT, or Police and Community Together, has been initiated by the White Lake Police Department (WLPD) to increase communication and keep residents informed.

Communication:

- If you see something suspicious, but not in progress, e-mail Sergeant Ivory, at mivory@whitelakepolice.com.
- If you see something suspicious that is in progress or needs immediate attention, call the WLPD at 248-698-4400.
- If you have an emergency, call 9-1-1.

The FBCA will send any information we receive from Sgt. Ivory including information about crime in our subdivision through the Remind 101 FBCA updates.

Vacation House Program

If you are going out of town for less than two months, you can sign up for the WLPD to check your property (including your doors and windows) twice a week.

If you are going out of town for more than two months, you can sign up for the WLPD to check your property at least six times per month.

You must sign up for each vacation at whitelakepolice.com.
