## Oakland County Pet Licensing

Oakland County has a new pet licensing process that started this year, 2026. The county has partnered with DocuPet to handle annual licensing for dogs.

Dog owners who live in Oakland County are required to license their dogs annually by visiting the [DocuPet website](#) to complete this the process. On the main page, pet owners are given the option to [License a pet for the first time](#), [Renew their pet's license](#), or [enter an access code](#) to access their account.

**Private Events**- Our Beach Lot is a great place to host celebrations . and events in any season. Contact a Board member to reserve the Beach Lot for your next event.

**Drive Safely**- Keep our neighbors and pets safe by adhering to the speed limit when driving through our neighborhood.

**RVs and Trailers** of any type are **NOT** permitted to be stored outdoors. Residents are able to park them at their home for only a few days for cleaning and maintenance. Please contact a board member when you plan to bring your RV or boat home for cleaning. We'd rather hear from you in advance, than hear from your neighbors.



**No Motor Vehicles**- With the warmer weather, residents are encouraged to enjoy swimming, canoeing, kayaking, and fishing at Allen Lake and Fox Bay, but please remember that motorized vehicles are **NOT** permitted on the Lake or Beach Lot, including jet skis and motorboats.

**Rules & Regulations**- Any structures including home additions, decks, sheds, pools, fences, etc. must be approved by the board (in addition to all required Township, County and State requirements. **Pick Up After your Pet**- Remember to keep pets on a leash and pick up after them when walking through the neighborhood. Keep our park extra clean by avoiding play areas including the beach. Disposable bags are available at the pavilion near the trash cans. Thank you for keeping our park and our neighborhood clean!
