# Lake Update

We had a couple of challenges in 2021. In July we had test samples reveal high levels of E. coli, which closed the beach for a couple of weeks. Once we got excellent samples, the beach was opened immediately.

Later, just before Labor Day, we had to close it again due to the presence of bluegreen algae blossoms, which are toxic -- especially to pets. This was a problem for many Michigan beaches. We requested a special water treatment from our treatment company, Aquatic, but due to this year's relentless parade of storms, we

had to wait for a clear forecast. Once we had the lake treated, we were able to open up the beach just after Labor Day.

We have learned a lot this year. We are hoping next year is more predictable and favorable. Our lake is our community's prized resource. Thanks to all that help support our efforts to make it better! It is wonderful to see more people swimming and enjoying the beach!

### **Annual Dues**


Just as a reminder, annual dues were due on August 1, 2021. If you have not paid your dues, please remit payment as soon as possible.
